Launched at the joint CCA-CCCM Congress in Halifax, June 27–29, 2011, the canada2012.coop website makes Canada the first nation in the world to have a full site dedicated to IYC. The site was created in partnership between CCA, the federal Rural and Co-operatives Secretariat and the Conseil canadien de la coopération et de la mutualité (CCCM). Over the summer, CCA is working on tools for customization and download, as well as promotional products that will be available for sale—the majority of items (for download and for purchase) will be available beginning September 2011.

At the provincial, regional and local levels excitement is building as co-operatives and credit unions are getting together to prepare for IYC2012. The section of our website, “Get Involved” allows individuals, co-ops, credit unions and communities to get ideas to participate in and to celebrate IYC. As part of the canada2012.coop website, we have created a new feature “Canada’s IYC messages” that allows people to share their ideas, thoughts and general messages about the International Year. This section of the site allows people to add their content, see the content others have added, and even view a world map that plots the messages.



IYC MESSAGING

CCA is taking the lead and developing common messaging for IYC, so that we are all “singing from the same song-book”. All messaging being developed builds from the foundation of the IYC theme: co-operative enterprises build a better world, and offers support to co-ops and credit unions to raise awareness and promote co-operatives for the 366 days of 2012.
